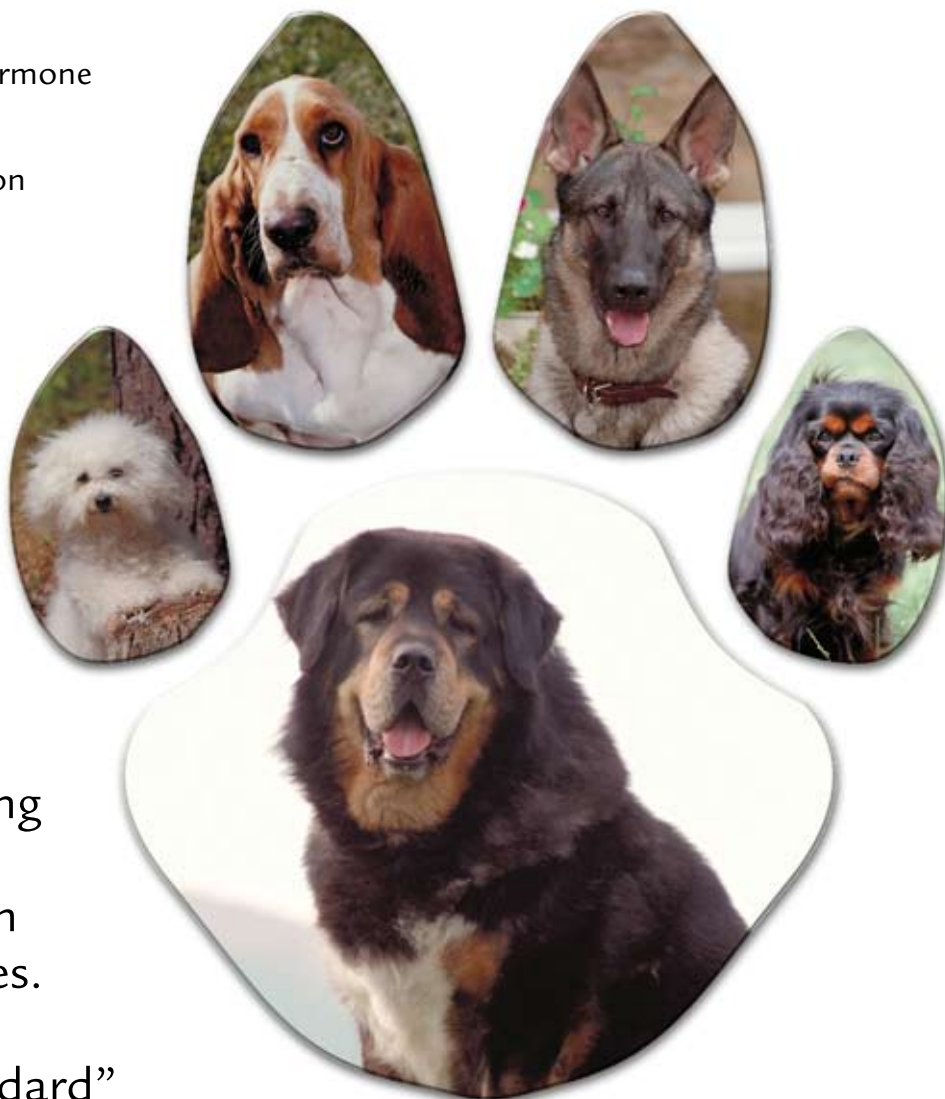

Soloxine brand of levothyroxine sodium. SUMMARY: Read package insert for full disclosure. INDICATIONS: For use in canine patients for correction of conditions associated with low circulating thyroid hormone (hypothyroidism). DOSAGE: The initial recommended daily dose is 0.1mg/10 lb. (4.5 kg) body weight b.i.d. Dosage is then adjusted by monitoring the T4 blood levels of the dog every four weeks until an adequate maintenance dose is established. The usual maintenance dose is 0.1 mg/10 lb. (4.5 kg) body weight once daily. ADMINISTRATION: Soloxine tablets may be administered orally or placed in pet's food. WARNING: Administer with caution to animals with clinically significant heart disease, hypertension or other complications for which a sharply increased metabolic rate might prove hazardous. Use in pregnant bitches has not been evaluated. CAUTION: Federal law restricts this drug to use by or on the order of a licensed veterinarian. SUPPLIED: Soloxine tablets: 0.1 mg, 0.2 mg, 0.3 mg, 0.4 mg, 0.5 mg, 0.6 mg, 0.7 mg, 0.8 mg, 1.0 mg in bottles of 250 and 1,000.
